On the day of the regatta payment confirmation has to be presented upon request (eg confirmation of transfer).

Foreign teams only pay half of the entry fees shown above.

### **General Regulations**

- In races 10 and 29 (JM-A 1x, JW-A 1x) lightweights may be judged separately depending on the number of registrations. Please state the <u>weight</u> when registering for these races. Weighing of the athletes will be done according to the ÖRV Rowing Competition Rules (RWB).
  - In races 28 (W 4x) and 8 (W 2x) the **masters** will be judged separately. Please state the <u>year of birth</u> when registering.
- 2. The regatta course on the Völkermarkt reservoir with weak current is straight and 500m long. There are 6 lanes with fixed launchers.
- 3. If there are more than 6 entries for one race, the race will be divided into sections.
- 4. The races are held at 5-minute intervals.
  - In SchM/W and JMB/JWB races the time gap required must comply with RWB regulations.
  - Boat classes and race order will be according to the list above.
- 5. According to the RWB the usage of Big Blades in SchM and SchW races is prohibited.
- 6. Junior licences according to the RWB.
- 7. The winner of each race (except the M 1x and W 1x pre-runs and the master races) will receive honorary prizes.
  - The overall most successful club receives the "Wanderpokal der Stadt Völkermarkt" (challenge cup).
- 8. Races 1 and 2 (M 1x and W 2x) are run in heats.
  - The 6 fastest of all heats move on to the finals and fight for the titles "King of the lake (KOL)" and "Queen of the lake (QOL)".
  - The winners of the finals receive a non-cash prize.
- 9. <u>Scoring for the challenge cup and ÖVM:</u> The winner receives as many points per seat as there were starters in the race. Each subsequent boat that finishes receives one point less per seat. The coxswains do not count. In combination crews the points are split between the clubs.

The best junior team will be awarded with the anniversary challenge cup "40 Years Section Rowing" donated by Reg. Rat. Ing. Alois Mrack. All SchM/W races that are held during the regatta are included in the evaluation. The scoring method is the same as for the challenge cup of Völkermarkt.

The best student team receives the anniversary challenge cup "50 years rowing section", donated by (Reg. Rat. Ing. Alois Mrack). Only SchM and SchW athletes are included in the evaluation. The scoring method is the same as for the challenge cup of Völkermarkt.

- 10. Participation in this regatta is at your own risk. Participants are responsible for their own insurance coverage.
- 11. **DOPING TEST**: It should be noted that doping tests may be carried out at any time during the regatta. For prescribed medication that may result in a positive doping test an <a href="EXEMPTION AUTHORISATION"><u>EXEMPTION AUTHORISATION</u></a> must therefore be obtained in advance and sent to the NADA Austria GmbH and the ÖRV. Forms for this purpose can be found on www.nada.at.

Omissions must be sanctioned by the ÖRV.

- 12. Data protection: The registered clubs confirm that the declared participants agree to the processing of their personal data by the organiser and the ÖRV for the purpose of informing the public about participation and results in accordance with the data protection regulations; this consent also applies to the publication of photos and film recordings.
- 13. Approved by the Technical Commission of the ÖRV on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2024 regarding the conformity to the rules and regulations of the ÖRV and any deviations thereof. The organizing club is liable for the compliance with all other (including official) regulations.
